














# Create Label or Page Modules to Display Course Content

What's the difference between these resources (modules)?

- A **Label** content appears directly on the course page.
- A **Page** appears as a link on the main course page. Then, students click the link brings them to a new separate page that contains the information/links/images/videos.

Lable Module	
	<p>This is what the label on the course page looks like now.</p> <p><b>Tip:</b> If teachers have set access restrictions on the Label, these will be displayed to the teacher. Labels are useful when gamifying your Moodle course, for example by revealing an image in a label only when a previous activity was completed.</p> <p><b>Tip:</b> Labels are also used to show important notes on your course page.</p>
	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. 'Turn editing on' in your course.</li> </ol>
	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Click '(+) Add an activity or resource' in a section.</li> </ol>
	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>2. Open 'Resources' tab and click 'Label' button.</li> </ol>
<p>▼ General</p> <p>Label text</p> 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>3. Add content in the 'Label text' editor.</li> </ol> <p><b>Tip:</b> Because the label uses the Text editor it is possible not just to type words but also to add images, links, media or code from within the labels' editor.</p>

	<p><b>Tip:</b> (Optional) You can use 'Restrict access' and set conditions to the label, e.g., show the label when student completed the assignment.</p>
	<p>4. Once all the content that you want on the Label has been added, select the button '<b>Save and return to course</b>'.</p>
<h2>Page Module</h2>	
	<p>2. '<b>Turn editing on</b>' in your course.</p>
	<p>5. Click '<b>(+) Add an activity or resource</b>' in a section.</p>
	<p>6. Open '<b>Resources</b>' tab and click '<b>Page</b>' button.</p>
	<p>7. In '<b>General</b>' section, enter '<b>Name</b>' of the Page. This is the name that will appear on the main course page.</p>
	<p>8. In '<b>Content</b>' section, add the page content into the '<b>Page content</b>' editor. The editor allows editing text formatting, and add images, links, media or code.</p>
	<p>9. Once all the content that you want on the Label has been added, select the button '<b>Save and return to course</b>'.</p>
