



Create Label or Page Modules to Display Course Content

What's the difference between these resources (modules)?

- A **Label** content appears directly on the course page.
- A **Page** appears as a link on the main course page. Then, students click the link brings them to a new separate page that contains the information/links/images/videos.

Label Module	
<p>Congratulations! You passed the quiz 😊.</p>  <p>Not available unless: The activity Assignment is marked complete</p>	<p>This is what the label on the course page looks like now.</p> <p>Tip: If teachers have set access restrictions on the Label, these will be displayed to the teacher. Labels are useful when gamifying your Moodle course, for example by revealing an image in a label only when a previous activity was completed.</p> <p>Tip: Labels are also used to show important notes on your course page.</p>
<p>Turn editing on</p>	<p>1. 'Turn editing on' in your course.</p>
<p>Add an activity or resource</p>	<p>1. Click '(+ Add an activity or resource' in a section.</p>
<p>Activities Resources</p> 	<p>2. Open 'Resources' tab and click 'Label' button.</p>
<p>General</p> <p>Label text</p> 	<p>3. Add content in the 'Label text' editor.</p> <p>Tip: Because the label uses the Text editor it is possible not just to type words but also to add images, links, media or code from within the labels' editor.</p>

	<p>Tip: (Optional) You can use 'Restrict access' and set conditions to the label, e.g., show the label when student completed the assignment.</p>
	<p>4. Once all the content that you want on the Label has been added, select the button 'Save and return to course'.</p>
<h2>Page Module</h2>	
	<p>2. 'Turn editing on' in your course.</p>
	<p>5. Click '(+) Add an activity or resource' in a section.</p>
	<p>6. Open 'Resources' tab and click 'Page' button.</p>
	<p>7. In 'General' section, enter 'Name' of the Page. This is the name that will appear on the main course page.</p>
	<p>8. In 'Content' section, add the page content into the 'Page content' editor. The editor allows editing text formatting, and add images, links, media or code.</p>
	<p>9. Once all the content that you want on the Label has been added, select the button 'Save and return to course'.</p>
