









# Embed YouTube Video in Moodle Editor

	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. In Moodle Editor, click on the  HTML symbol button for switching to HTML mode.</li> </ol> <p><b>Tip:</b> If you cannot see the HTML symbol button, click icon  to show more buttons on the tool bar.</p>
	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>2. To get the video embed code on YouTube, click on <b>'Share'</b> on your YouTube video webpage.</li> </ol> <p></p>
	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>3. Click on the <b>'Embed'</b></li> </ol>
	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>4. Click on <b>'Copy'</b>. The link will be copied to clipboard.</li> </ol>

5. Paste the YouTube video embed code in the HTML textbox.
